Minutes of the Meeting held on 27.09.2021

A General meeting of IQAC & NAAC with the Faculty members of the college was held on 27.09.21 in the Staff room at 3:00 pm. Prof. Rachna Srivastava Principal, VKM, IQAC coordinator Prof. Indu Upadhyaya and NAAC Coordinator Prof. Niharika Lal addressed the meeting and discussed the below-mentioned issues –

- 1. Choice-based/ Elective courses—The college runs CBCS in 2 subjects at UG level (Philosophy, Economics) and in 5 subjects at PG level (Psychology, Political Science, History, Home-Science and Economics).
- 2. Value-added Course Two value added courses have been introduced in the current academic session
 - a. Self-Realization Through Theosophy
 - b. Young Skill India
- 3. Field activities/Studies/Internships- It was decided that more field studies and internships should be undertaken by the Departments in order to connect theory with practical. It was decided to constitute an internship committee in order to encourage the students to participate in internships organized by various institutions of National and International importance.
- 4. Research Funds It was decided that more research funds need to be raised by the faculty members (from industry, different agencies and other funds).
- 5. It was decided that a workshop/ seminar on Industry-Academia collaboration or Intellectual Property Rights should be organized. Efforts should be made to procure funds from different academic bodies for the same.
- 6. It was decided to have more collaborative activities in the College. The College itself collaborates with its parent-institution, Theosophical Society for a certificate course.

Dr. Indu Upadhyay suggested that research-paper-writing and book editing should also be brought under the definition of collaborative project as it can enhance the quality of research.

- 7. E-content needs to be developed and the prepared content should be as per the structure and directives of UGC approved programs like SWAYAM/MOOC etc. Some suggestions were given in this regard
 - Collaboration is required in establishing or using recording studio for developing e-content.

- 8. More MOUs should be undertaken with other colleges/ national and international universities like Princeton (Incharge-Dr. Shubhra Sinha), Cambridge (Incharge Dr. Purnima) and alike.
- 9. Some issues related to Criterion-3 of NAAC, were briefly discussed by Dr. Anshu Shukla which included Data-providing of Research publications/ Innovation and Extension Award to the Faculty members etc.
- 10. It was reiterated that the APAR should be submitted in proper format.
